

Food Distribution is held on the 1st and the 3rd Wednesday of every month beginning at 9:00am and ending at 12:00pm. Below is a list of eligibility criteria that includes the necessary documents required at the time of signup and renewal.

- Residential Eligibility: South Sumter County (south of Coleman).
- Necessary Documents: Total household income, Social Security card and D.O.B. (for all household members) Photo ID and proof of residency.
- Financial Eligibility: The following shows a yearly gross income for each family size. If your household income is at or below the income listed for the number of people in your household, you are eligible to receive food.

The chart below is effective July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020.
